Kicksled Loans

The Winter Active for Life Equipment Lending Library offers a small inventory of Nordic Kicksleds on a short-term loan basis during the winter. Requests for a Kicksled loan can be made at any time during the winter season.

WHO CAN BORROW KICKSLEDS?

Kicksleds are available to all eligible borrowers who are a **RPAY Community/ Associate Member**. Eligible borrowers may include schools, First Nation Governments, recreation departments, and other non-profit organizations with liability insurance coverage.

Borrowers can request a maximum of 2 kicksleds for up to 2 weeks. If available, additional kicksleds can be borrowed for a shorter time (i.e. a weekend).

WHAT IS THE EQUIPMENT USE AGREEMENT?

The Equipment Use Agreement must be signed by an authorized club member of the 'Borrowing Party'. This contract ensures RPAY and the Borrowing Party (organization using the equipment) agree to the conditions of equipment use, storage and return.

HOW DO WE PAY THE DAMAGE DEPOSIT?

RPAY understands that equipment is subject to normal wear and tear. When there are signs of equipment misuse (broken pieces of equipment, big scratches on ski bases due to use on gravel/roads, missing equipment), RPAY charges the replacement cost.

A commitment to pay for loss or damages beyond regular wear and tear is required to borrow WAFL Lending Library equipment. There are two options.

1. Provide a purchase order number from your organization, school, First Nation or municipality.
- OR
2. Provide a WAFL Promissory Note signed by an authorized representative of your organization, community association, or club.
