



Winter Active for Life Equipment Library

The Winter Active for Life Equipment Library offers a small inventory of cross-country skis, boots and poles as well as snowshoes on loan for the winter season. Nordic Kicksleds are available to borrow on a short-term loan basis.

WHO CAN BORROW EQUIPMENT?

Eligible borrowers are a **RPAY Community/Associate Member**. Eligible borrowers may include schools, First Nation Governments, recreation departments, and other non-profit organizations with liability insurance coverage.

Cross country equipment loans to rural Yukon community/associate members are prioritized.

Snowshoe and Kicksled loans are available all RPAY community/associate members.

WHAT IS THE EQUIPMENT USE AGREEMENT?

The Equipment Use Agreement must be signed by an authorized club member of the 'Borrowing Party'. This contract ensures RPAY and the Borrowing Party (organization using the equipment) agree to the conditions of equipment use, storage and return.

HOW DO WE PAY THE DAMAGE DEPOSIT?

RPAY understands that equipment is subject to normal wear and tear. When there are signs of equipment misuse (broken pieces of equipment, big scratches on ski bases due to use on gravel/roads, missing equipment), RPAY charges the replacement cost.

A commitment to pay for loss or damages beyond regular wear and tear is required to borrow from the WAFL Equipment Library. There are two options.

1. Provide a purchase order number from your organization, school, First Nation or municipality.

OR

2. Provide a WAFL Promissory Note signed by an authorized representative of your organization, community association, or club.
